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In the Year Two Thousand and Nine  
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## AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX CREDIT FOR PERSON 65 OR OLDER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           There shall be added to Massachusetts General Law chapter 62, Section 6(k)(9), the following:-
- 2   (10)   Upon request, in writing, by a taxpayer who is 65 years of age or older, a city or town shall  
3   furnish the taxpayer a written record of the taxpayer's "real estate tax payment" as defined in this  
4   section (k) for up to three prior calendar years free of charge to the requesting taxpayer, but no city or  
5   town shall be required to furnish a written record without charge for any given calendar year for which a  
6   written record has been previously provided except that a city or town shall provide duplicate written  
7   records for a reasonable charge in accordance with regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of  
8   Revenue.
