### AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 56 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first two sentences and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following two sentences:—
- 4 Every fifth year, the commissioner shall certify as to whether the board of assessors is assessing
- 5 property at full and fair cash valuation. Once certified, a city or town may classify in the manner set out
- 6 in this section for the year of certification and for the four years next following said year of certification.
- 7 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall be applicable to all certifications issued by
- 8 the commissioner after the effective date of this act.
