AN ACT RELATIVE TO A COMMISSION ON ADVERTISEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 There is hereby established a special commission to study the feasibility of permitting
- 2 private sector advertising on city and town school buses. The Commission shall study and
- 3 analyze whether private sector advertising on state websites is a practicable initiative to
- 4 generate revenue.

- 6 The Commission shall consist of 3 members of the Senate, 5 members of the House of
- 7 Representatives, and 3 persons to be appointed by the governor.
- 9 Said study shall include, but not be limited to, the issue of fair market compensation for use of
- state property, the ability to screen advertisements and the authority of state agencies to sell
- 11 advertising space.

13 The Commission shall issue a report no later than 270 days after its first organizational meeting.
