**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CIVIL SERVICE PREFERENCE FOR A CERTAIN FIREFIGHTER IN  
THE TOWN OF MILTON.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.     Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a son or daughter of  
2 Robert Byron, who was injured in the performance of his duty as a firefighter in the town of Milton, who  
3 passes the required written and physical examination for entrance to the firefighter service shall have  
4 his or her name certified for original appointment to the firefighter service before all other persons on  
5 the eligible list for appointment; but if more than 1 person is eligible pursuant to this act, the names of  
6 such persons shall be certified in order of their respective scores on the open competitive civil service  
7 examination for firefighter.

9           SECTION 2.     This act shall take effect upon its passage.
