AN ACT RELATIVE TO INFORMATION SHARING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 37 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 13 the following new section:-
- 4 Section 13A. Notwithstanding the provisions of the general laws of Massachusetts chapter 66 or any
- 5 other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the
- 6 commonwealth shall be provided with identifying information upon request from the records or files of
- 7 any agency, department, commission, division or authority of the commonwealth for the sole purpose
- 8 of identifying and locating individuals wanted on default or arrest warrants; provided, that only
- 9 identifying information including, but not limited to, name, date of birth, all pertinent addresses,
- telephone numbers and social security numbers shall be made available to sheriffs' departments.
- 11 Information about any individual, except the individual against whom a default or arrest warrant was
- issued, may not be requested by sheriffs or deputy sheriffs under this section.
