AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSSESSION OF WEAPONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 170 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby amended in section 1 by striking “federal,
2 state or municipal” in each instance where it occurs and inserting in place thereof the following:
3 “federal, state, county or municipal”.

5 Section 2. Said chapter is hereby amended in section 2 by striking the words, “state police and
6 municipal police” and inserting in place thereof the following: “state, county and municipal law
7 enforcement agencies”.
