AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATE BARGAINING UNIT FOR CORRECTION PROGRAM OFFICERS, YOUTH SERVICES PROGRAM OFFICERS, AND TRANSITIONAL PAROLE OFFICERS. .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 150E of the general laws is hereby amended by adding  
2 a fifth paragraph as follows:

3           The appropriate bargaining unit for employees of the executive branch in the titles of Correction  
4 Program Officer, Youth Services Program Officer and Transitional Parole Officer shall be a unit  
5 which includes all persons in said titles and any successors to said titles.

6           SECTION 2.

7           In establishing the above described unit, employees in the affected titles shall retain their current  
8 contract and their current collective bargaining representative.
