AN ACT ROTATING THE SALES TAX HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no legislation shall be
2 enacted exempting certain non-business sales at retail in the commonwealth of tangible personal property,
3 as defined in section 1 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, from excise, more than one calendar season
4 in a 4 year cycle.
