AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN EXEMPTION FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The excise imposed by Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2004 Official Edition, shall not apply to a motor vehicle owned and registered by a member of the armed forces
3 while such member is on active service.

5 SECTION 2. The words “armed forces”, as used in this act, shall mean the following: —

6 United States Army, Army of the United States, United States Navy, United States Naval Reserve, United States
7 Coast Guard, United States Coast Guard Reserve, Army Nurse Corps, Navy Nurse Corps, United States Air Force,
8 and United States Air Force Reserve, including women’s branches of said armed forces.
