## AN ACT RELATIVE TO RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 84 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:-
- 3 Highways and town ways shall be kept in repair at the expense of the town in which they are situated,
- 4 so that they may be reasonably safe and convenient for travelers at all seasons.

- 6 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 84, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by adding the
- 7 following sentence:- Railroad crossings at grade with such highways and town ways shall be kept in a
- 8 reasonable state of repair at the expense of the owner of said railroad crossing
