## AN ACT TO REDUCE UNDERAGE DRINKING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 34 the following section:-

2 Section 34A <sup>¾</sup>

3 A licensee licensed under this chapter except Section 29 shall be required to place a warning label on  
4 single and multi-pack containers of beer and single and multi-pack containers of wine to include the  
5 following:

6 WARNING: A person who provides alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age, if convicted under  
7 section 34 could be imprisoned for up to 1 year and fined up to \$2,000 or both such imprisonment and fine.
