**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING EMS BENEFITS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Section 100 is hereby amended in line 14 after the word  
2 “death,” by inserting the following:— “or if an emergency medical technician is killed or  
3 sustains injuries in the performance of his duties which result in his death;” and is further  
4 amended by striking every instance therein where the following phrase appears: “firefighter,  
5 police officer or corrections officer” and inserting in place thereof the phrase:— “firefighter,  
6 police officer, corrections officer or municipal or public emergency medical technician.”

7           SECTION 2. Chapter 32, Section 100A is hereby further amended by striking every instance  
8 therein where the following phrase appears:— “firefighter, police officer or corrections officer”  
9 and inserting in place thereof the following phrase:— “firefighter, police officer, corrections  
10 officer or municipal or public emergency medical technician.”
