AN ACT RELATIVE TO A JUNIOR OPERATOR SEAT BELT REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 8, subsection (e) of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the fifth paragraph, the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 5 A person holding a junior operator's license who operates a motor vehicle without a seat belt
- 6 shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars. This provision shall be enforced by law
- 7 enforcement agencies and the operator may be stopped even if there is no other violation of
- 8 motor vehicle laws or any other offense.
