## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CRIMINALLY NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 30A. A person is guilty of criminally negligent homicide when,
- 2 with criminal negligence, he causes the death of another person. For purposes of this section,
- 3 "criminal negligence" is the failure to perceive a substantial and unjustifiable risk that is of such
- 4 nature and degree that the failure to perceive it constitutes a gross deviation from the standard of
- 5 care that a reasonable person would observe under the circumstances.
- 6 Whoever is guilty of criminally negligent homicide shall be punished by imprisonment in a
- 7 house of correction for not more than  $2\frac{1}{2}$  years and a fine of not more than \$10,000.00.
