AN ACT TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUG CLINICAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by 1 2 striking out the last paragraph, inserted by section 1 of chapter 80 of the acts of 2000, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:— 3 For the purposes of this section, "licensed mental health professional" shall mean a licensed 4 5 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental 6 7 health clinical specialist, or a licensed alcohol and drug counselor I.
