- 7 Section 88. The Department of Revenue shall not assess an individual who is an employee or owner-
- 8 employee within the meaning of section four hundred and one (c) of the Code and who excluded or
- 9 deducted elective contributions to plans defined in section four hundred one (k) within the limitations set
- out in section four hundred and two (g)(1) of the Code for tax years prior to 2009.
