### AN ACT ALLOWING MUNICIPAL EMPLOYMENT AFTER RETIREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Notwithstanding any other  
3 provisions of this section, any person who is receiving a pension or retirement allowance from the  
4 commonwealth may be employed in the service of a city, town or district without being subject to the  
5 hours and earnings restrictions of the previous sentence.

6 SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of said section 91 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
7 striking out the word "shall", in line 90, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- ,with the  
8 exception of any person receiving a pension or retirement allowance from the commonwealth and  
9 employed by a city, town or district, shall
