AN ACT ALLOWING THE TOWN OF WARE TO SELL THE OLD COUNCIL ON AGING  
BUILDING AND ITS PROPERTY AT AN AUCTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the requirements in Chapter 30B of the General Laws or any
- 2 other general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Ware may sell at an auction the Old
- 3 Council on Aging Building and land at 11 Church Street and the South Street School and land on
- 4 South Street.
