## AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BELLINGHAM TO GRANT ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOL .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2   licensing authority of the Town of Bellingham may grant one additional license for the sale of all  
3   alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under section 15 of said Chapter 138 to  
4   Antoine H. Khoury, 3 Mechanic Street, Bellingham, Massachusetts. Said license shall be subject  
5   to all of said Chapter 138 except section 17.

6   Notwithstanding any General or special law or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the local  
7   alcohol licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other location.  
8   Said license may be re-issued by the local alcohol licensing authority at the same location if any  
9   applicant for said license files with said authority a letter in writing from the Department of  
10   Revenue indicating that said license is in good standing with said Department and that any and  
11   all applicable taxes have been paid.

12 If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, such license  
13 shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining  
14 thereto, to the local alcohol licensing authority. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of  
15 the General Laws, or any other General or special law to the contrary, the local alcohol licensing  
16 authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location and under the same  
17 condition specified in the preceding paragraph; or act or do anything in relation thereto.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
