AN ACT CHANGING THE MAXIMUM REQUIRED AGE FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority 2 of the same, as follows: 3 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 1 to 2, the words "and maximum ages 4 established for school attendance by the board of education" and inserting in place thereof the 5 6 following words:- age established for school attendance by the board of education and the age of 18. 7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall apply to all cities, towns, and regional school districts, 8
- 9 notwithstanding section 27C of chapter 29, and without regard to any acceptance or
- appropriation by a city, town or regional school district or to any appropriation by the general 10
- 11 court.
