#### AN ACT CREATING A JAIL DIVERSION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 19 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, are

2 hereby amended by inserting after section 21 the following section:-

3 Section 22. Subject to appropriation, the commissioner shall establish a jail diversion program. 4 Such program shall provide opportunities to divert individuals with mental illness out of the 5 criminal justice system and into community based mental health and substance abuse services 6 where such diversion is clinically appropriate and consistent with public safety. This program 7 shall establish, monitor and evaluate pilot projects and ongoing programs in cities, towns or 8 regions of the commonwealth, as determined by the commissioner, taking into consideration 9 available resources and need, using promising or established program designs for effectuating clinically appropriate, safe and effective diversion of such individuals. 10
