AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF DOVER AS THE GOVERNOR  
FRANCIS W. SARGENT BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The bridge spanning the Charles River, connecting Farm Road in the town of  
2 Sherborn and Bridge Street in the town of Dover shall be designated and known as the Governor Francis  
3 W. Sargent Bridge, in honor of his many years of service to the citizens of the Commonwealth. The  
4 department of highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance  
5 with the standards of the department.
