AN ACT ESTABLISHING A COMMUTER TAX DEDUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after subsection B.(a)(15) the following subsection:-
- 3 "(16) Amounts expended by an individual for fuel used pursuant to commuting to and from his
- 4 place of work or education or commuting for the purpose of seeking work. In the case of a single
- 5 person or a married person filing a separate return or a head of household, this deduction shall
- 6 apply only to the portion of the expended amount that exceeds \$1500, and the total amount
- 7 deducted shall not exceed \$4500. In the case of a married couple filing a joint return, this
- 8 deduction shall apply only to the portion of the amount expended by each individual that exceeds
- 9 \$1500, and the total amount deducted shall not exceed \$4500 for each individual. The
- 10 commissioner of revenue shall adopt regulations necessary for the implementation of this
- 11 section.
