# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION ON PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES TO MUNICIPALITIES IN WHICH GROUP HOMES ARE LOCATED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SEC 1. There shall be a special commission to make a study and investigation of  
2 establishing a payment in lieu of taxes mechanism for municipalities in which group homes are  
3 located. The commission shall be charged with evaluating options and the practices of other  
4 states, collecting data, and making policy recommendations that will be used to develop a  
5 statewide procedure to compensate municipalities for the properties and buildings occupied by  
6 group homes.

7           SEC 2. The commission shall consist of the secretary of administration and finance or his  
8 designee, the secretary of health and human services or his designee, the commissioner of the  
9 department of mental health or his designee, the commissioner of department of developmental  
10 services or his designee, the commissioner of the department of housing and community  
11 development or his designee, the commissioner of the department of revenue or his designee, the  
12 chairs of the joint committee on mental health and substance abuse, the chairs of the joint  
13 committee on revenue, the senate minority leader or his designee, the house minority leader or  
14 his designee, and the executive director of the Massachusetts Municipal Association or his  
15 designee.

16           SEC 3. The commission shall report its findings, recommendations, and annual cost of its  
17 recommendations, as well as any proposed legislation, to the clerks of the senate and house of  
18 representatives and to the chairs of the house and senate committees on ways and means on or  
19 before December 31, 2009.

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
