# AN ACT ESTABLISHING UNIFORM WAGE COMPLIANCE AND RECORDKEEPING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 20A of chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
2	Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
3	thereof the following sentence:-
4	The provision of this chapter shall not be applicable to any cause of action accruing more
5	than three years prior to the date of filing in court of a criminal or civil action.
6	SECTION 2. Section 15 of chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
7	Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place
8	thereof the following sentence:-

Such records shall be kept on file for at least three years after the entry date of the record.
