## AN ACT EXEMPTING ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 61A of chapter 31, as so appearing is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 2 fifth paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3           Any applicants shall be exempt from undergoing the in-service physical fitness examinations if the
- 4 applicant is active duty military personnel and has successfully passed a military physical fitness test
- 5 within the last six months.
