AN ACT EXEMPTING ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
