AN ACT EXTENDING THE SENIOR CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX CREDIT TO DISABLED  
PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6(k) 1 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of “CPI” the following definition:-  
3 ““Disabled person”, an individual who has been determined disabled for purposes of Social  
4 Security Disability Insurance or Supplemental Security Income programs created under title II  
5 and XVI, respectively, of the Social Security Act.”

6 SECTION 2. Said Section 6(k) 2 of said chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
7 hereby further amended by inserting after the word “older”, in the second sentence, the following  
8 words:-or a disabled person.
