## AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING REGULAR COMPENSATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended, by inserting at the  
2 end of the first paragraph, in the definition of “regular compensation” the following: -

4 “Regular compensation shall not include indirect or in-kind payments, or any payments, such as  
5 for housing, lodging, travel, retirement benefits, welfare benefits, workers’ compensation  
6 benefits, the value of non-cash job related accessories and benefits, job related expense  
7 payments, automobile usage, insurance premiums, dependent care assistance, tuition or any other  
8 payment in-kind and all payments in any medium other than cash received by an individual from  
9 his housing employing unit.”
