AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PENSIONS OF POLICE AND FIRE DISPATCHERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION1.

- Section 20 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after section (5) (*l*) the following:
- 4 (m) Upon receiving a petition signed by a majority of the public safety dispatchers in a
- 5 municipality so requesting, the Retirement Board shall direct the System's actuary to determine
- 6 the actuarial cost of designating said public safety dispatchers as fire or police signal operators or
- 7 signal maintenance repairmen within Retirement Group 2, as specified in Chapter 32, Section 3.
- 8 The most recent actuarial valuation of the Retirement System shall be used as the basis of the
- 9 actuarial calculation. For purposes of this section, "public safety dispatchers" shall be defined as
- any civilian, not functioning in the capacity of a sworn police officers, who is dispatching police
- officers and/or fire fighters.
