AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ISSUANCE OF FIREARM IDENTIFICATION CARDS
AND LICENSES TO CARRY FIREARMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 140: Section 129B is hereby amended by adding after Clause 9, the
2 following new clause:-

3 Clause 9½. Notwithstanding the provisions of Clause 9, if the cardholder is on active duty with
4 the armed forces of the United States, the card shall remain valid until the cardholder is released
5 from active duty and for a period of not less than 90 days following said release.

6 SECTION 2. Chapter 140: Section 131 is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph
7 of subsection (i), the following new paragraph:-

8 If the licensee is on active duty with the armed forces of the United States, the license shall
9 remain valid until the licensee is released from active duty and for a period of not less than 90
10 days following said release.
