AN ACT INCREASING PENALTIES FOR DRIVING WITHOUT A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official
2 edition, is hereby amended in line 10 by striking the words “of not less than one hundred nor
3 more than two hundred dollars” and further amended by inserting in place thereof the following:-
4 of five hundred dollars for a first offense, by a fine of not less than five hundred nor more than
5 one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than ten days, or both, for a second
6 offense, by a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than two thousand dollars or by
7 imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or both, for any subsequent offense.
