AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR HEALTH-RELATED RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH COSMETOLOGY.

- 4 of a regulation relating to any public health risks, as designated by the Board of Registration of
- 5 Cosmetologists, shall be punished by a fine of up to \$1000."
