AN ACT MAKING THE MEMBERS OF LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES LIABLE FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PAYMENT OF WAGES STATUTE .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 148 of chapter 149 shall be amended by striking the second sentence of the
- 2 fifth paragraph and replacing it with the following:

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of the general laws, the president and treasurer of a corporation (whether a for-profit corporation or a not-for-profit corporation), all members and 4 5 managers of any company formed under chapter 156C, the partners of any partnership, limited 6 partnership or limited liability partnership governed by or registered under any provision of chapters 108A or 109, and all members and managers of any such company and any officers or 7 8 agents or managers having the management of such corporation, company or partnership shall be deemed to be the employers of the employees of such corporation, company or partnership 9 within the meaning of this section. The provisions of this section shall be construed liberally for 10 11 the accomplishment of the purposes thereof.
