AN ACT PERTAINING TO FIREFIGHTER TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition is amended by
- 2 adding at the end of section 91 the following new paragraph:-
- 3 (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (d) inclusive, a firefighter, retired for
- 4 superannuation, based on: age and length of creditable service may be employed in the service of the
- 5 Commonwealth in excess of 960 hours.
