## AN ACT PROTECTING THE PRIVACY OF TAX ASSESSORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking (e)
- 2 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
- 3           “(e) The name and address of any law enforcement or public safety personnel or tax assessor
- 4 who so requests shall not appear on the street list and such names shall not be disclosed to any
- 5 person.”
