AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATE FOR FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1 2 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: - "The registrar shall furnish to owners of private passenger motor vehicles who are active members, members 3 retired in good standing, or the immediate family member of a firefighter killed in the line of 4 5 duty, distinctive registration plates which shall display on their face a design indicating their 6 status as firefighters. No such plate shall be issued or renewed until proper certification has been 7 made to the registrar by the chief of the fire department in which the applicant serves. There 8 shall be a \$10 fee for said plate in addition to the established registration fee for passenger motor 9 vehicles which shall be transferred to the Massachusetts Firefighters Academy Trust Fund pursuant to section 165A of chapter 6. 10
