## AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATE FOR OLYMPIANS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: - “The registrar shall  
3   furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles who are a member of, or  
4   have competed as a representative of, the United States of America’s Olympic team in the  
5   Olympic Games a distinctive registration plates which shall display on their face a design  
6   depicting the “Olympic Rings”. No such plate shall be issued or renewed until proper  
7   certification has been made to the registrar by the United States Olympic Committee confirming  
8   the applicants said membership or participation.”
