AN ACT PROVIDING THAT DECISIONS OF THE LABOR RELATIONS COMMISSION IN REPRESENTATION CASES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 14 of Chapter 30A of the General Laws of the Commonwealth is  
2 hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following new paragraph:—  
3 Decisions of the labor relations commission in representation cases under Chapter 150E of the  
4 General Laws shall be considered final decisions of the commission and shall be reviewable  
5 judicially in accordance with the provisions of this Section 14.
