## AN ACT REGARDING UNIFORM POLICE IDENTIFICATIONS CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 41, section 98D of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the current
- 2 section and inserting in its place the following section:
- 3 Each city or town, and the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority Transit Police Department, shall
- 4 issue to every full time police officer employed by it an identification card bearing the officer's
- 5 photograph and identity. The secretary of public safety shall have the authority to promulgate
- 6 regulations relative to the issuance of identification cards to police officers. Such card shall be carried
- 7 on the officer's person, and shall be exhibited upon lawful request for purposes of identification.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 22C, section 19 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the first
- 9 sentence the following sentence:
- 10 The secretary of public safety shall have the authority to promulgate regulations relative to the issuance
- of identification cards to state police officers.
