## AN ACT RELATING TO COSTS OF APPEALS BY THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28E of Chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding, after the third paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:
  
- 3 A defendant who is not indigent, as defined by Chapter 211D of the General Laws, and is therefore not
- 4 entitled to public representation, is responsible for his own costs on appeal, unless the Commonwealth
- 5 loses the appeal or the Commonwealth's application thereof is denied. In such cases, a defendant is
- 6 entitled to be reimbursed for the costs he incurred as a result of the appeal, including reasonable
- 7 attorney's fees, subject to approval of the court.
