AN ACT RELATIVE TO A DENTAL, PRESCRIPTION, AND VISION COVERAGE OPT-OUT CLAUSE .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111M of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by adding to Section 1 at the end of that section the following paragraphs:

4 "Minimum Creditable Coverage" may include an individual or group health plan as described by
5 Section 1 of Chapter 111M notwithstanding that any such health plan does not include any of the
6 following:

7 (i) dental coverage;

8 (ii) prescription coverage;

9 (iii) vision coverage;

11 provided that the individual covered by such plan elects in writing to opt out of the coverages (i)-
12 (iii) above or any one of them.

14 To opt out, the covered individual shall file a written opt out election with his health plan
15 provider stating which coverage has not been elected (i)-(iii). An opt out election shall be filed
16 annually by the covered person by January 15 for the current year to which the election applies
17 or during the open enrollment period for his plan. The covered individual shall retain a copy of
18 the opt out election filed with his health plan provider.

20 This opt out election satisfies the requirement for demonstrating creditable coverage under
21 paragraph 1(a). This opt out election also qualifies a taxpayer under paragraph 2(b) to indicate to
22 the Commissioner of Revenue that such person, as of the last day of the taxable year for which
23 the return is filed has creditable coverage in force as required by paragraph (a).
