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AN ACT RELATIVE TO AN AFTERSCHOOL EDUCATION PILOT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, there is hereby 2 established a pilot program to provide after school and summer educational services operated by a non-3 profit organization staffed by certified teachers and college aged tutors. This pilot shall provide 4 comprehensive academic and social supplemental education in a safe and supportive environment. The 5 pilot shall be focused to cater to the needs of students in low-income urban communities, specifically 6 those urban youth that require additional assistance to become academically proficient. The students 7 shall be instructed for two and a half hours in core curricula such as math and literacy using a multi-8 cultural approach. In addition, the program will include the opportunity to work with tutors on 9 homework, community service, and team self-esteem and relationship building. 10 SECTION 2: The pilot shall be instituted in the cities of Lowell, Worcester, Boston, Plymouth, and
- 11 Springfield.
