## AN ACT RELATIVE TO ARCHAIC CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 18 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
