AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSURING THAT MOTORCYCLISTS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16 AND 18 ARE PROVIDED WITH ADEQUATE EDUCATION RELATIVE TO THE PROPER SAFETY AND OPERATION OF A MOTORCYCLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 90, as appearing in the 1998 Official Edition and amended
2 September 1, 2007, is hereby amended by adding to the end of paragraph 2 of said section the
3 following new clause:

5 (f) For a motorcycle license, applicant must have successfully completed a Motorcycle Basic
6 Rider Course (BRC) approved by the registrar and presented, in such form as the registrar may
7 require

9 SECTION 2. This bill shall take effect July 1 2009.
