AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHAPTER 23 OF THE GENERAL LAWS .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11W of Chapter 23 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 4, after the words “accompanied by a”, the
3 following:

6 SECTION 2. Section 11W of said Chapter 23 is hereby further amended by striking out the third
7 sentence.

9 SECTION 3. Section 11W of said Chapter is hereby further amended by inserting after the
10 second sentence, the following:

12 “The apprentice identification card shall expire one year from the date of issue. The apprentice
13 shall submit an application to the Division for an updated apprentice identification card. Said
14 application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$35 paid by the apprentice or the program sponsor.”

16 SECTION 4. Section 11W of said Chapter 23 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by
17 inserting, in line 16, after the word “apprentice;” as it first appears, the following words: “the
18 date on which the apprentice identification card expires;”
