## AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 Commonwealth and its political subdivisions may not employ the use of Global Position System
- 3 technology, or other similar technology, to monitor or track employees of the Commonwealth or
- 4 its political subdivisions, unless the implementation and terms of use of such technology is
- 5 mutually agreed to in a collective bargaining agreement. In the absence of a collective
- 6 bargaining agreement, the implementation and use of such technology shall be subject to the
- 7 provision sections 52 to 56, inclusive, of Chapter 7 of the General Laws.
