AN ACT relative to creditable service for Paul A. Bouvier.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the Worcester County retirement board shall credit Paul A. Bouvier with creditable  
3 service for the period beginning on April 1, 1989 to April 3, 2000 inclusive for the purpose of  
4 determining his superannuation retirement allowance under Chapter 32 of the General Laws.  
5 Before the date that any retirement allowance becomes effective for Paul A. Bouvier, he shall  
6 pay into the annuity savings fund of the retirement system of the Worcester County retirement  
7 board in one lump sum or installments, upon such terms and conditions as the board may  
8 prescribe, an amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from  
9 his regular compensation for such previous service, plus interest.
