AN ACT RELATIVE TO DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF MEDFIELD
AS THE SENATOR LEVERETT SALTONSTALL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The bridge on Route 109, bridge number M-11-003, in the Town of Medfield shall
2 be designated and known as the Senator Leverett Saltonstall Bridge, in honor of his many years of service
3 to the citizens of the Commonwealth. The department of highways shall erect and maintain suitable
4 markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
