AN ACT RELATIVE TO DOUBLE POLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34B of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "pole;" in line 5, the following:- provided
- 3 further, that a city or town may enforce this section by the enactment of a local ordinance or
- 4 bylaw prohibiting double poles beyond the ninety days authorized by this section, violation of
- 5 which may be punishable by a fine not to exceed a maximum of one thousand dollars per
- 6 occurrence.
